The ultimate Blue Lagoon cruising experience of the magical Fiji Islands.

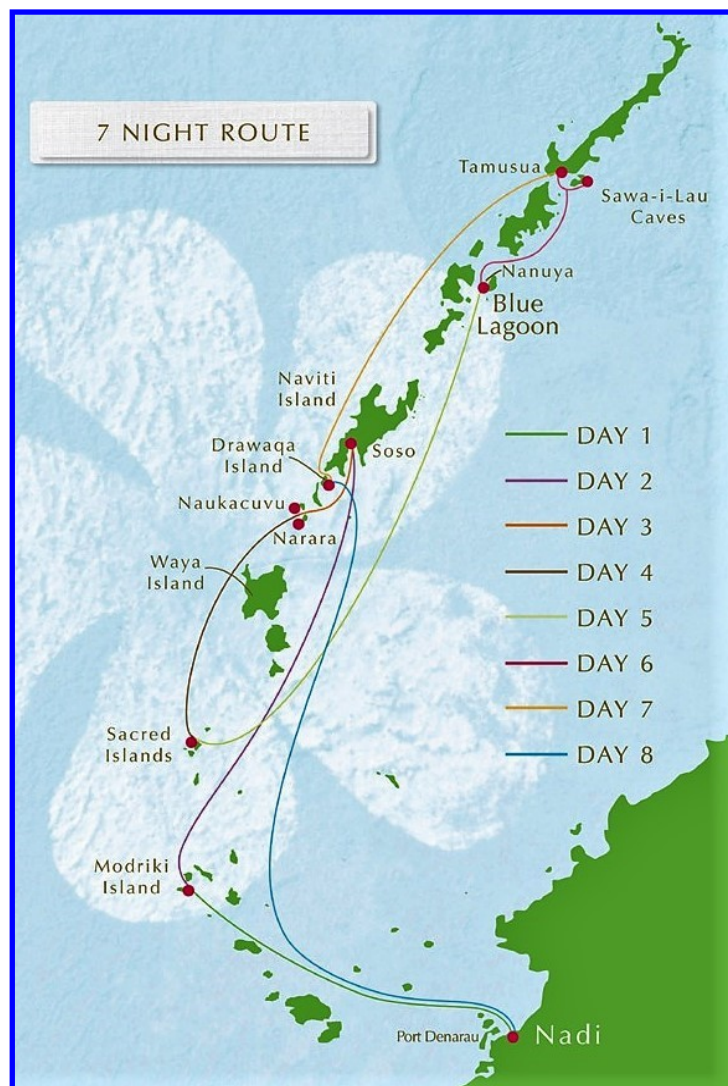

With a maximum 4 hours cruising per day, you'll spend more time seeing, doing and experiencing Fiji!

Experiencing the unspoiled South Pacific is what we're all about, and we don't expect you to experience it all from a sun lounger on *Fiji Princess*! With a maximum of four hours cruising per day, we'll get you into the islands, to experience first-hand all the wonders they have to offer. A highlight of a Blue Lagoon cruise is our breathtakingly beautiful Nanuya Lailai, where we have a wonderful private beach available exclusively for your enjoyment. All activities are optional, so if you're so inclined, you're more than welcome to laze on-board and just admire the views. Activities include:

Swimming in warm, crystal waters surrounding the Yasawa and Mamanuca Islands. Every morning at 6am, there is a chance for the 'early birds' to head ashore for a spot of swimming and throughout each day there is plenty of time for cooling off in the sea!

Snorkeling trips are a-plenty! The colorful underwater world will astound you. Our crew know all the best spots and can give lessons if required. Equipment is provided.

- Take a guided walk across an island to one of the South Pacific's most remote cafes, 'Lo's Tea Shop'
- Learn the Fijian arts of basket weaving, wood carving and cook traditional dishes
- Get to know the 'reef locals' with the fascinating activity of fish feeding
- Or really get to know the 'reef locals' and swim with sharks or manta rays (seasonal)
- See the coral reef without getting wet from our glass bottom boat
- Snorkel to your heart's content (we offer several snorkeling trips per day)
- Sit down to a dinner you'll never forget; dine on a delicious Fijian 'lovo' feast on our private beach under the stars
- Step ashore at famous little Modriki Island
- Attend an island village church service
